WHAT TO WEAR? HOW TO DO MY HAIR AND MAKEUP?

For the majority, the costumes will arrive to Picture Day and to the theatre for the Dress Rehearsal and Performances for the students. Be sure to check with your teacher as to what **you** are responsible for, i.e. – shoes and tights, hair accessories, etc.

Picture Day is like a trial run for the Dress Rehearsal and Performances. Hair and makeup requirements are the same for Picture Day as the Dress Rehearsal and Performances. If your child needs help getting their hair or makeup done, please ensure they arrive with enough time for someone to help, that being a staff member or a parent volunteer. KBS is not responsible for providing hair and makeup essentials – be sure to bring what is needed for your child.

Hair: All classes will have specific hair styles, so be sure to inquire if you are unsure. Teachers have most likely discussed this in class with their students, but the message may have not made it home.

Makeup: ALL female students should be wearing makeup as follows:

- Foundation, blush, eye liner, mascara, Eye shadow and lipstick.

For eye liner and mascara, black or brown is acceptable. Students should have rosy cheeks, so they do not look pale in their pictures or on stage. If students are not wearing eye liner, mascara and blush, their faces will be washed out from the bright stage lights. Earth tones are acceptable to eye shadows, or add a little colour to match the costume your child is wearing, if appropriate.

Lipstick: All students should be wearing REVLON 740 “Certainly Red”

ONLY EXCEPTION – if your child is wearing a pastel coloured costume, then a more pink lipstick will be appropriate.

Students in the following numbers are to wear false eye lashes for the Dress Rehearsal and Performances – not necessary for Picture Day

West End Story, Hot Honey Rag, Tap Your Troubles Away, Venom, Break it 2 U, Boogie Shoes, Crescendo, Redemption, Love is Blind, Las Senioritas, Move Under Love, Hanky Panky, The Journey Begins...

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RECITAL WEEK

Monday June 14th – This is our last day at the Mlacak Centre. Regular classes will take place as usual. Some classes may be asked to attend a class at the teacher’s discretion for some dances that need a little more work.

Tuesday June 15th – We all move to the Ron Maslin Playhouse. Use stage entrance only (rear double doors) Part One will be starting at 4:30pm. Students in Part Two should arrive by 6:30pm. Bring a snack – however, no food or drink is permitted in the theatre. **All students must wear correct practice clothes with proper hair.** Once the student is finished, they are free to leave, or may stay to watch. When you arrive to the theatre it is much easier the teachers and those helping if students sat in their groups so when they are called to the stage it is much easier to locate everyone.

Wednesday June 16th - This is a sharp 5:30pm start time, students in early numbers should arrive by 5:00pm. Part Two should arrive by 7:00pm . **All students must wear correct practice clothes with proper hair.**

All costumes are to be turned into the Wardrobe this day – ironed, labelled, and ready to go for the remainder of the week.

Stage Crew dad should attend if possible, even if for a portion of the evening.

Supervisor Moms should pick up their name tags in the main dressing room.

Thursday June 17th – Rehearsal start time is 6:30pm . Dancers in the first half should arrive by 5:30pm to get ready to start In full makeup, hair and costumes. This evening will run exactly like a regular performance, and it is a CLOSED rehearsal. Dancers should be dropped off and picked up at the stage door entrance.

Public Performances – Friday & Saturday June 18 &19

Students should be sure their personal possessions are labelled, and should avoid bringing valuables to the theatre. We ask that students respect the theatre throughout the week and during the performances as it is our “home” for the week.

We still need dressing room helpers! Please sign up in the office – this goes for parents helping in our boys’ dressing room as well! We are also looking for a few more dads to help out Saturday night to assist the Stage Crew.

Dancers – don’t forget to bring your smiles! The dress rehearsal and all 3 shows will be video taped for the DVD ☺
